ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, 11/22/63 AFO

Review of items in the possession of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, revealed Social Security No. 433-54-3937. In addition, he had in his possession an altered Selective Service card in the name of ALEK JAMES HIDELL, Local Board 4, Fort Worth, No. 42-224-32-5321. In addition, the subject had in his possession a snub-nose Smith and Wesson .38 caliber, SN 510210. This was the gun used to kill Dallas police officer.

This information telephonically furnished ASA MALON L. JENNINGS.

On 11/22/63, Fort Worth, advised SA JENNINGS that Selective Service records reflect LEE HARVEY OSWALD, born 10/18/39, registered with the board 9/14/59 and he has SSN 41-114-39-532. He listed as his nearest relative, a brother, ROBERT OSWALD, 7313 Davenport Street, Fort Worth. The records indicated he served in the U. S. Marine Corps from 10/24/56 to 11/7/59 as an electronic operator and was honorably discharged. The records further reflect his civilian occupation is that of a radio operator.

advised that Selective Service records contain no registration for ALEK JAMES HIDELL with Selective Service No. 42-224-32-5321. advised that the 42 prefix in the Selective Service No. 10r HIDELL is assigned to the State of Utah and the number 224 is the local board, but the highest number of local boards in Utah is 39.

advised she does not have registration for OSWALD under Selective Service No. 43-354-3937. This Selective Service No. prefix 43 is the State of Vermont, and the number 354 is for a local board, and there are only 14 boards in Vermont.

advised that the two afore-mention Belective Service numbers appear to be fictitious.
