ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY

On 11/23/63 at 3:40 PM, [REDACTED] telephoned and advised that RONNIE DUGGER, editor of "Texas Observer", in Austin, Texas, had called him by phone requesting that he be permitted to interview [REDACTED] concerning Communism. [REDACTED] stated that DUGGER desired to interview him in his hotel room, but that he had declined. He also stated that Mr. T. GEORGE MARRIS, Senior Editor of "Look" magazine had called his residence and wanted to take [REDACTED] his wife and daughter out to dinner. [REDACTED] declined insofar as his daughter and wife are concerning, but accepted the invitation for himself. He said that MARRIS told him that he wanted general information such as why an American citizen like OSWALD would adopt Marxism. He also said that he wanted to interview [REDACTED] along the lines of the danger of Marxism. [REDACTED] will advise the results of this interview. b7D
