Exemptions claimed, records withheld, records relating to critics and their books This 6/4/75 memo from a Dallas supervisor to SAC withholds the name of the supervisor, the name of the FBIHQ Supervisor who had phoned him and perhaps other names. There are four more withholdings, all attributed to (b)(7)(C).

The record itself indicates that the Headquarters supervisor "has been assigned to review a book written by George O'Toole \dots "

In this connection I note that Dallas had a large file of records on books on the Kennedy assassination and its investigation that have not been provided.

I note also that in this case when the supervisor, whose initials are EEH which makes him readily identifiable, dictated his memo, he did not indicate what files they would be routed to. The 89-43 file designation is written on this one as on the earlier one of which I noted the same to be true.

If these kinds of books reviews have been made available from Headquarters files, I am not aware of it.

Although I have received several references to my own books, I have not received anything of this nature relating to any of my many books. Under my Privacy Act requests I should have received them.

He stated O'TOOLE makes a discussion of a tage in which OSWALD denied he had assassinated for Links wanted to know if FITZGEPALD KENNEDY.
