Dear Mr. Secretary:

For some months now, on behalf of my client, Mr. Harold Weigherg. I have been seeking to get from the Department of Justice a topy of all documents supplied to the Bon Street Magistrate's Court in London by Hr. David Calcutt on behalf of the U.S. Covernment in the public proceeding to require the extradition of Mr. James Fari Ray in June-July, 1968. (See attached correspondence).

The Department of Justice has replied (evasively) that it does not have copies of such documents and (unevasively) that, even if it did have copies, they would not be made available under the Freedom of Information Act, despite the fact that he London proceeding was public.

Does the Department of State, either in its files in Washington or London or elsewhere, have such documents or copies thereof, and will they be made available promptly to Mr. Weisberg per this request?

As the Freedom of Information Act calls for prompt restonses on requests for information, I sincerely hope you will favor us with a prompt and unequivocal reply.
