SUBJECT: Harold D. WEISBERG

On January 20, 1955, pursuant to your instructions, the writer took the attached Secret Service report dated December 15, 1954, concerning the subject and his chicken farm, to Mr. Frederic S. O'Connor, Special Assistant to the Secretary of State for his review.

Mr. O'Connor was advised that though the situation outlined in the attached report would appear to contain only the remotest element of risk from a security standpoint, you were nevertheless disturbed by the publicity being given the fact that Mrs. Dulles purchases her chickens from the subject.

Mr. O'Connor stated that though he shared your concern, there were, nevertheless, other factors which had to be considered. Mr. O'Connor, is, however, going to advise Mrs. Dulles of the situation, and tell her that if she is in any way dissatisfied with the subject's service, this would be a good time to discontinue it.
