Dear Mr. Weisberg,

It is kind of you to write me your letter of April 18 which I can answer only after much delay because, although if I have practically spend the last 4 weeks in the American hemisphere, the 90 miles which separate Cuba from the US seem a greater distance than from here to the moon.

I am looking forward to the Oswald in New Orleans text (it is probably already in my office waiting for me). But obvious I have not managed to convey my ideas to you in my previous letter: what I feel the time has come for what is a clear indictment of who is responsible for the Whitewash. You have taken the Warren Report to peaces, you have proved it was a farce but you have not yet made a clear indictment of who is responsible: certainly you know or have a theory.

Up to now everybody has reported on the Report, on facts starting with the assumption, with the conviction that Oswald was framed. Now is the time to start from the other side with a clear set theory on what happened and prove the theory right. This I think is what you can and must do.
