Mr. CHARLES BAUGH, 677 Fielding Avenue (Terrytown), Gretna, Louisiana, a graduate student in the Department of Biochemistry, Tulane University Medical School, observed a photograph of LEE HARVEY OSWALD and advised he did not know OSWALD and had never seen him. Mr. BAUGH volunteered the information that approximately two years ago he began receiving unsolicited literature mailed by the Fair Play for Cuba Committee (FPCC) at the address 6440 South Claiborne Avenue. He stated he continued to receive this literature up until the time that he moved to his new address. He stated he had never belonged to the FPCC and often wondered how the FPCC obtained his name and address.
