

Falange, etc. Summary of information given to Duane Wilson, COI, and dictated to his secretary following telephone call from Chase:

Sorriano Rojas, Manila. Industrialist, represents big US corporations, inc. Philip Morris. During Spanish revolution regularly contributed 50,000 Spanish dollars a month to the Fascist cause.

Sylvester Sanchos, director St. Thomas University at Manila (priest) Makes speeches in which he looks forward to the day the Philippines will again be part of the Spanish Empire.

Elizalde, Philippine Commissioner in Washington, important Falangist.

Spanish consulates at San Francisco and Los Angeles (esp. S.F.) are two of the most important Falange agents in the US. Tie-up between Native Daughters of California and Casside Espana, Los Angeles Falange Club.

Most important of all: Jose del Castano, Spanish Consul General at Manila, regional head of Falange in Philippines and also in charge of all axis liason in the Philippines.
