by the FBI and gave her address. She called to state that
he had given this address merely because he did not have
another residence address. When questioned more closely
she advised that she was not supposed to have anybody living
with her at the Dallas Housing Authority Project and as a
consequence did not want her address used for fear of newspaper publicity.
