Transcript of interview for Unsolved Musteries proggram aired 3/31/93 in Unsolved Mysteries folder.

This black Judas presided over the deliberately dishonest non-investigation of the King assassination by the HSCA. He is marely truthful much as he pretended to agonize over that crime an Osacar performance, never investigated and never intended to investigate the crime itself, and he pretends the opposite on all counts throughout the interview .. "e is personally responsible for HSCA's failings in its King sector. The portrait the program pemmitted him to make of himself is the opposite of what it should be. He could and should have done as that sector's chairman what he belated indicates should have been done- and he knew it! He also lies, as in saying that J.C. Hardin's name was blacked out. Or he admits gross failure. Those records were disclosed to me in CA 75-1996, not to the committee. The committee later got acopies. The name is not obliterated in the copies I got and thus it was not obliterated in the copies in the FBI's public reading room. If by any chance they were blacked out in the committee's copies the most perfunctory inquiry would have disclosed that they were not in my copies. HSCA knew it was getting copies of what I'd already gotten. If it found the FBI withholding from a committee of the Congress what it had given to a private citizen and what was available to any and all in its publix reading room it would have had a major FBI scandal. This is to repeat the obvious, that in addition to its other faults the committee was entirely incompetent.
