Dear Roger,

I'm pleased that you phoned last night. I'm pleased also, as I forgot to tell you, that you listened to me and rethought your position on letting Livingstone quote at such great length. While I still think you would have been better off in the long run if you had used his abusiveness to deny him the right to use any of it, your decision was principled, your own to make, and whether or not you are later criticized for it, nobody really has the right to do that.

I sent my response not to him but to Carroll, again to show him that Harry is so ignorant of the subject and/or such a liar that he lied about what he said in his own book he claimed I'd not read!

What you told me Carroll said to you about Groden's claim to copyright on the pictures and Xrays may not have been precisely what he told you but in the event it was I tell you what I was told long ago by someone who had had a friendly relationship with both of them. Groden claims the right to the enhancement was his. I understand he stole that from HSCA.

If I've not asked it before, I hope you can let me have clippings from the papers you see and I do not on the coming assassination commemoration events on TV and the books. I kept what grew into a large file on the 25th that I think will be of value in the future. I will do that this time. This time I may also want to include some of that in writing.
