Under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552, et. seq., I respectfully request all records of the Potomac River Naval Command in any way relating to the autopsy of the late President John F. Kennedy, which occurred on or after November 22, 1963 at the National Naval Medical Center. This request includes any records received by the Potomac River Naval Command from any other command, department, bureau, agency or person, as well as records generated by the Command itself.

I require this information for personal, and not a commercial use.

I further request a waiver of fees upon the ground that this request concerns a matter of grave and ongoing public interest, and it is the recently expressed policy of the Congress of the United States that full disclosure be made of all records pertaining to the assassination of President Kennedy.
