MRS. FENNER stated that her husband answered the door and per her instructions, he advised MR. AYNESWORTH that she had no comment to make. AYNESWORTH was accompanied by another individual whose identity was not disclosed but who stated to MRS. FENNER's husband that perhaps she would like to hear what they intended to print in the Dallas Times Herald. According to MRS. FENNER, this too was answered with "no comment". Attached below is a copy of the card which AYNESWORTH left with MR. FENNER.


At approximately 2:45 p.m., this date, my telephone rang and I answered it - Mrs. Fenner.
