If you have not already sent Steve Burton a set of your revised CD listings, would you please? The address I gave you is four too large. It should be 316. However, I think in routine mailings it is better to use the Committee address, Box 150, 308 Westwood Plaza. ZZZ L.A. 90024.

If I may ask an additional favor of you, intended to make this more useful for me: if you can have one of your girls mount the three sections on one fairly stiff backing or in an appropriate-size file folder, stapled in place, I can keep it by the desk rather than getting up and going into the files, where I have to bend this to keep it anyway. Hope you can. Thanks.

Paul and his boys now have all the indexes. I sent them more than 700 pages recently, bringing them up to date. If they could get the cards typed, they could come up with an IBM consolidated index of all the indexed docs. If Paul hasn't sent you what they've done, ask him.

I think they have inadvertently duplicated what I did two years ago. I believed, on sight, that the enormous suppressions in CD 7 were for the protection of the radical right. I had all suppressed listings typed alphabetically from the index. Penn was supposed to check it out but didn't. Steve now reports the suicide or murder of Newton Armstrong, Jr. Both are in CD7, #508.

On the stapling, if you do not have one large enough, unless things have changed, the folding room has. If stapled at both sides of the top of left side, the things can be used faster and with less dog-eating.
