Dear Bud,

We both thank you for your letter of the 13th. We do appreciate it and as I've learned, things can always happen. Even when we don't have reason to expect it.

The understanding is that anyone can make copies. It is to be a fully public archive.

As of now, and I have no reason to believe there will be any change at least for some time, the persons to get in touch with will be either Jerry McKnight, who you know, and Charles Kuhn. Charles is the new librarian. He's been a librarian at Hood for years and seems to be a nice guy.

Jim says eh thinks you may be interested in having copies of slides of all the frames of the Zapruder film. I have permission to make them under an agreement reached in CAs 78-0322/0420 but because Groden never got around to it didn't. When Nigel Turner and Sheila Cogan were here I suggested that he use this authority to have the slides made and when he is finished give them to me. He has a separate agreement with Zapruder on the film, I understand. My recollection is that he agreed.

Before he sent it Jim discussed with me his letter of the 13th to the Archives.

As I read it it occurs to me that if you want a set of slides for yourself it will be a simple matter for Groden to make two exposures each shot instead of one and that you'd have a set for no more than the cost of the film and processing. Or, I can insist on two copies, one for use and one for safekeeping for future use.

As you ask, I'll inform Hood via a copy of this letter.
