Re Bureau telephone call to Dallas from Supervisor WILLIAM O. CREGAR, 6/2/72; Legat, Mexico City, letter to Bureau and lhm dated 2/24/64; Dallas airtel to Bureau and lhm dated 6/1/64; and Dallas airtel to Bureau 6/3/64.

Pages three and four of lhm dated 2/24/64 referred to above reflects that on 2/20/64 PEDRO GUTIERREZ VALENCIA examined three photographs of an unidentified possible white male American suspect which depicted this individual in the following poses:

1. Attired in a white shirt and tan trousers, holding what appears to be a courier-type pouch under his left arm and examining a wallet-type folder which it appears may contain one or two documents resembling passports.
2. Attired in the same dress described above and holding the wallet-type folder in his left hand and inserting this folder into the courier-type pouch held in his right hand.

Dallas airtel to Bureau 6/3/64 furnished the Bureau the original cut down photograph exhibited to Mrs. MARGUERITE C. OSWALD.
