Fonctorwald appeared as a guest on a radio program > called, "Sunday Dialogue" featured by radio station WAVA This was a two-hour show. The first hour Fenstervald was interviewed by the narrator regarding the purpose of the Rational Committee to Investigate Assassinations and the second hour was answering questions telephonically from the inquiring public.

Pensicroald stated that the Warren Commission report is a "fairy story" and that it is false and one of the biggest "cnow jobs" ever done. Le said the Committee's office will be located at 927 15th Street, Northwest, Washington, D. C., iltelephone number 347-3037.

Fensterwald mentioned at present he has no staff but i coes have a Board of Directors which include Jim Garrison, New Grlooms District Actorney, William Turner, former FBI Agent, Fred J. Cooks Paris Flarmonde, author and others. He hopes to I build an investigative stall through funds obtained from private sources and donations. Thereafter, the staff will conduct necessary investigation into the assassinations of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, Eartin Luther King, and li Robert F. Kennedy.

Fensterwald intends to link forces with various individuals around the country namely Jim Garrison, Harold Weisberg, JosichThompson and others to form an organization so that a large pool of information relating to the assassinations will be available.

When this information becomes available, it is Penstermald's intention to force, persuade or emberrass the assessination of the first will come out. Covernment to appoint a new Commission or for Congress to reopen the investigation conserving the assessination of President Kennedy. He contends the truth will come out.

Feneterwald stated he believed there was a definite conspiracy involved in the assassination of President Kennedy and that there was more than one assassin involved. He indicated he courts with the constant of the constant

with others of the group with whom he has become aligned, that shots which were responsible for President Kennedy's death came from the front, rather than from the rear.

Fensterwald briefly discussed his background as being associated with Senator Long's committee on wire tapping and had been involved in investigating the Internal Revenue Service and the Department of Justice. He was asked by the narrator if he intended to investigate the FBI. Fenstervald said he was not doing an investigation of the FBI as such, however, will have the advantage of having William Turner on the Board of Directors as well as Fred J. Cook, who are knowledgeable about the activities for the FBI and other Government agencies. Fenstervald mentioned Paris Flammende, whom he described as an author who recently wrote the book "Why President Kennedy Was Killed." Flammonde takes the position in this book that there was a conspiracy involved and analyzes the possibilities of who were involved.

Comments made by Penstervald regarding the investigation of President Kennedy conducted by the Warren Commission readily revealed that he was not familiar with the full facts or the information contained in the Commission's report. Further he has aligned himself with individuals whom we know to be severe critics of the Varren Commission, the FBI, the CIA and other Government lagencies.

He indicated another purpose he has is "to restore some sense of integrity to our Government," as an unsolved nurder of a President casts doubt on the Government. Therefore, he will make efforts to bring an honest investigation "by our Government" into the assassination of President Kennedy.

From comments made by Fensterwald and because of the known background of the individuals with whom he is associating, it can be anticipated this group will undoubtedly make unwarranted attacks against the FBI in the future.
