Dear Mr. Shepherd:

President Kennedy's motorcade left Dallas Love Field, turned left on Mockingbird and went to Lemmon Avenue. The motorcade turned right on Lemmon and went to Turtle Creek and turned right again. Several blocks later, Turtle Creek appears to become Cedar Springs because Turtle Creek makes a sharp turn to the right and traffic flows smoothly into Cedar Springs. A few more blocks the motorcade crossed Maple Avenue, continuing on to Harwood. Just about 1 block to the west on Maple Avenue is Wolf Street. Wolf is a very narrow little street and separates the Stoneleigh Terrace Hotel property from the Maple Terrace Apartments. The Stoneleigh Terrace Hotel is at 2927 Maple Avenue and the Maple Terrace Apartments are at 3001 Maple.

For many years Paul M. Raigorodsky, a Russian-born oil man, lived in Apartment 314 at the Stoneleigh Terrace Hotel. When he died in 1977, he was living in the next block at the Park Terrace Apartments, at 3131 Maple Avenue. (I am enclosing a Xerox of some clippings about Raigorodsky.) deMohrenschildt wrote a letter to Raigorodsky from Miami on June 2, 1963. (See WC Vol. 9, p. 278; WC Vol. 19, p. 547)

October 19, 1955, George deMohrenschildt rented Apt. 208 at the Maple Terrace Apartments. (CD 554, p. 3) *also 9H18; 9H203*

Spring of 1956, Jeanne LeGon moved into Stoneleigh Hotel. (CD 730, p. C:19) Jeanne stayed at the Stoneleigh a short time then moved into George deMohrenschildt's apartment in the Maple Terrace. (CD 730, p. C:23)

On January 1, 1957, George and Jeanne were living in the Stoneleigh Hotel. (CD 534, p. 4) I am almost certain this is wrong. It should be Apt 208 at the Maple Terrace.

They did (and do) have a few small business establishments in both the Stoneleigh and the Maple Terrace. It is my opinion that the Social Security records are correct. (CE 1692)

Lewis McWillie is NEVER listed in any telephone directory or city directory in Dallas. However, if the Social Security records are correct, McWillie was deMohrenschildt's next-door neighbor in the Maple Terrace -- deMohrenschildt lived in Apt. 208, and McWillie in Apt. 210. McWillie apparently moved in on August 6, 1956, and deMohrenschildt had been in Apt. 208 since October 19, 1955.

I hope some of this helps you.
