My reason for Thermofaxing is to ease the time and cost burden on Paul. However, if any pages are not clear enough, I will supply the. I have bought another box of 3M paper and have already made a heavy dent in it preparing for litigation. I simply cannot think of buying another, or it was financially foolhardy to get this one. Many obligations are coming due all at once, and there simply is no money.

The old Thermofax machine is not too bad if the material to be copied is not too wide. The center will over-expose and the ~~right~~ edges underexpose if the copy is wide. In this case, while it was not often too wide, where it isn't clear, it was too far to one side, which had about the same effect as being too wide.

I glanced at this in haste and wrote the memo. I'd welcome any observations you have after reading it.

Rhodes and Angel are my friends, to sign the letters Johnson writes for them, for he leads with his chin. Or, theirs. I suspect they are wondering which is likely to be more hurtful, writing or not writing.
