EDWARD VOEBEL, FOUR NINE ONE SIX CANAL STREET, NEW ORLEANS, DURING INTERVIEWS NOVEMBER TWENTYFIVE, SIXTYTHREE, ADVISED HE JOINED CIVIL AIR PATROL PAREN CAP END PAREN DURING

NINETEEN FIFTYFIVE SCHOOL YEAR WHILE AT BEAUREGARD JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL THROUGH FELLOW STUDENT, ROBERT ESTAVE. HE ATTENDED MEETINGS ABOUT ONCE A WEEK AT MOISANT AIRPORT, KENNER, LOUISIANA, AND CONTINUED DURING NINETEEN FIFTYSIX AFTER VOEBEL WAS IN CAP ABOUT SIX MONTHS, DAVID WILLIAM FERRIE TOOK COMMAND OF CAP UNIT AND VOEBEL BEGAN TO LOSE INTEREST. VOEBEL PERSUADED

OSWALD TO JOIN CAP AND OSWALD ATTENDED TWO OR THREE, POSSIBLY FOUR MEETINGS AT THE MOST.

OSWALD TOLD VOEBEL TRIP TO MOISANT AIRPORT TOO FAR TO ATTEND MEETINGS AND DECIDED TO JOIN CAP UNIT WHICH MET AT NEW ORLEANS MUNICIPAL AIRPORT. VOEBEL LATER LEARNED OSWALD NEVER ATTENDED MUNICIPAL AIRPORT MEETINGS OF CAP. VOEBEL BELIEVED OSWALD USED CHANGE OF UNITS AS EXCUSE TO HIM TO GET OUT OF CAP AS BELIEVED OSWALD DID NOT LIKE AUTHORITY, DRILLING, AND HAD BEEN TALKED INTO JOINING BY VOEBEL. VOEBEL COUND NOT RECALL IF FERRIE COMMANDER OF CAP WHEN OSWALD ATTENDED MEETINGS.

BUREAU AND DALLAS NOTE EDWARD VOEBEL WAS INTERVIEWED ON NEW ORLEANS TV PROGRAM NOV. TWENTYFOUR, SIXTYTHREE DURING WHICH HE RELATED HE AND OSWALD AT ONE TIME FELLOW MEMBERS IN C A P ., NEW ORLEANS. ON SAME PROGRAM DAVID WILLIAM FERRIE MENTIONED AS BEING FORMER COMMANDER OF NEW ORLEANS C. A. P. UNIT.
