RE: DAVID WILLIAM FERRIE

DAVID WILLIAM FERRIE telephonically contacted the writer on 11/29/63 and advised that through contacts made he has determined that OSWALD was allegedly a member of the Moisant Squadron of the CAP. He informed that a Captain JIM COSGROVE was commandant of that squadron.

FERRIE stated he had talked to ED VOEBEL, who allegedly was the first individual to report that OSWALD had been a member of the CAP and that VOEBEL's recollection of OSWALD's attendance and membership in the CAP was very vague. He said that VOEBEL had informed him that after the group had finished their recruit training a number of recruits visited FERRIE at his home, 1302 Clay Street, Kenner, La. and VOEBEL believed that OSWALD had been in that group who visited at FERRIE's home.

FERRIE also said that he had learned that ROY TELL, JR., who lives on Xenia Street, remembers OSWALD vaguely, as having been in and out of the Moisant Squadron of CAP. FERRIE said that TELL also recalls that OSWALD showed up at TELL's home with GEORGE WALTER or WALTHER and a MARSHALL PARKER.

FERRIE also informed that JOE LISBON, who was last known to be employed as a ticket agent for Delta Airlines was an instructor at the Moisant Squadron of CAP as was PATRICK LIVINGSTON, who was last known to be employed as ticket agent for Delta Airlines.

3) Will endeavor to locate and interview GEORGE WALTER or WALTHER and MARSHALL PARKER re their knowledge of activities and associates of OSWALD.

4) Will locate and interview JOE LISBON and PATRICK LIVINGSTON, reportedly employed as ticket agents, Delta Airlines, for any information concerning OSWALD.
