The above persons involvement in this matter is that as of 11/22/63 he was residing which David William Ferrie at 3330 Louisiana Ave Prkwy.

89-69-684. This is an interview with attorney ". Wary Gill on 11/27/63 at which time he advised. He said that he had gone to Ferrie's apartment at 3330 Louisiana on 11/23/63 and found Layton Martens a young men at Ferrie's apartment. Gill said he told Martens of allegations against Ferrie in that Ferrie might be involved in the assassination plot against Kennedy. That Jack Martin had indicated that Ferrie was involved in such a plot. That he told Martens not to get involved but cooperate with authorities.

89-69-680p7 is a 302 with David William Ferrie in which he stated that he telephone Laytor Martens on 11/24/63 from Alexandria, La. and was told by Martens that Ferrie was being accussed of being implicated in the assassination of Pres. Kennedy.

89-69-158. This is an interview with Layton Pätrick Martens on 11/25/63 in which he advised that he had been resding with Ferrie since 11/17/63. Martens said that Ferrie has been a family friend for about five years and first because acquainted with Ferrie in 1956 through the CAP. He said that he had been thrown out of his own residence on 11/17/63 and Ferrie asked him to come live with him. MARTENS said that he first became acquainted with the Cuban Revoluntionary Front in April, 1961 and assisted this group until 8/61 when he left to go to school at Lafayette, La. His association with this group was to visit consulates and local businessmen to secure funds. Through this group he met Archaca Smith In 8/61 he, Ferrie, Melvin Seeley and Andrew Blackmon were arrested by the JPSO and Ferrie was charged with Vag and Crime Against Nature. He said that another member of this

Marte's informed that on 11/24/63 he received a telephone call from attorney G. Wray Gill regarding Ferria. Gill claimed that at the time of Oswalds arrest in Filas a library card of Ferrie's was found on Oswald arithat accroding to takk Jack Martin Ferrie was involved in the assassimation of mennedy. Martens aid that he knows Martin to be a personal enemy of Ferrie and Martin had indicated that Ferrie had allegedly made a statement that the President should be killed.

He advised that also on 11/24/63 he got a cell from Ferrie and told Ferrie of the conversation with fill. Ferrie told Martens that he did not know Oswald.

Coffey said he was a member of the CAP from 1954 to 1957 and was a member of the Moisant Squadron. Coffey said that he was not acquarted with Oswald had never met Oswald and that Ferrie is never mentioned to him that he and Ferrie were considering a possible tipe to Houston, Texas to relax and they were fittere sted in a skating rink and he asked Coffey to goalang. The three of them left on 11/22/63 at about 9:00 pm. (F 11/23/63 they visit ed the skagting rink in Houston and on 11/24/63 Ferrie called his residence in "ew Orleans from Alexandria, La. and talked to Karker Layton Martens at which time Ferrie learned of allegations that he was involved in the asmasimation.
