St. Louis and Leavenworth, which is understandable. There have been a series of disasterous intrusions into the case by Stoner and Jerry, who may or may not be under influence in it. After the most recent two I really unloaded onhim, wielently and at length, without even taking time to put my thoughts together and with no expurgation. He took it so well it astounded me. No protest at all. Bud, who can't be trusted with anything, has never made any effort to cope with any of this. He is much to anxious to hold onto the case in his quest for a fame he can't buy and can't otherwise earn. As best one can by remote. I've tried to cope with this. I've told Jerry that Schoolfield is a big crock, but he palms it off as prejudice because of his politics. It may or may not be important for him to know the details. Sch. was brought in for a delicacy by Stoner, when Stoner theoretically was out and staying out. We'll have until after the 10th. because it will not be until at least then before Jerry can be back in Chicago. I can never be sure how these strange peaple will reason, if the process can be falled reason with them. As if now I have a hunch that it might do good in a number of ways for both James and Jerry to fully understand the kind of judgement Stoner has and the kind of consequences it can bring. Sch can be another example. So, I'd like Jerry to see that file and probably afterward I'd like James to have it. Jerry could send it with a note saying I thought he might find it of a little interest, or I could send it. Jim, disgisted at Bud, finally took the bull by the horns last weeks after I reported the last two stupidities to him. He was to have called James - something he has never done - and told him to clamp all those flapping jaws or else. But it is a horse-barn-door situation already. This insanity that has never stopped and about which Bud has never done anything has just cost two important witnesses ink the hearing. Bud has also done no work at all. Jim and I have done that, with only the prevention of things that had to be done by Bud. He and Jin are barely talking now. it is that bad, and if Bud didn't know a damned thing about the case and won't take time to learn I'd have been entirely out before now. As it is, my understanding with Jim is that I'd help through the preparation of the petition and after that I'd see. As of now I have an enormous amount of entirely unpaid work invested in this, Jin has done the same thing for several months, and we neither can trust Bud for anything. It took Jim too long to come to this realization. Now that he has, I think, out of a sense of public obligation, he'll stick for six months anytay. When we are together I can tell you more if you want to know. You should have detectedmy at itude when you were here and it is not changed, nor is there basis for it. Bud does only bad things and thinks they are good because of his Garrisonian paranoia. In any event, the situation is very bad, one of the bad things that have to be contended with is these crazy statements by Stoner et al and Jerry under, I think, his/their influence and James' faith in those rabid ones, thus on the chance, perhaps remote, the desire for Jerry and James to have the detail on Schoolfield. If you haven't time, I'll make copies from my copies, but they'll not be as clear, and I think it would be very good for Jerry to read them in the presence of an experienced person who can explain why Sch has to be a very bad guy. I have told Jerry that if hakes another single public statement, even on them weather, without an ok from one of the lawyers, I'm out, staying out, and none of the work I've not given Jim will ever be available to James. Incidently, I also mean it. I'll be speaking to Lesur soon. If he is going to see James anytime soon it might be better if he hands James the clippings, not to attract interest by the censors to the Schoolfield connection, which they may not know yet.
