ON THIS DATE, TON DAVIS, LOCAL HEAD OF THE JOHN BIRCH
SOCIETY, STAMFORD, CONN. AREA, ADVISED THAT AN INDIVIDUAL
KNOWN TO HIM IN NEW YORK CITY AND NOT FURTHER IDENTIFIED BY
HIM, HAD HEARD A RADIO BROADCAST AT TWO ZERO FIVE PM, SUNDAY,
NOVEMBER TWENTY FOUR, OVER RADIO STATION WHN, NEW YORK CITY.
THIS BROADCAST REPRESENTED A TRANSOCEANIC REPORT BY A HEARST
NEWSPAPER CHAIN CORRESPONDENT NAMED FLUGER /PH/ FIRST NAME
POSSIBLY SERGE. FLUGER ALLEGEDLY IN THIS BROADCAST MADE
STATEMENT THAT HARVEY LEE OSWALD HAD NOT BEEN WORKING IN A
FACTORY IN THE SOVIET UNION, BUT HAD ACTUALLY BEEN ATTENDING
ESPIONAGE AND SABOTAGE SCHOOLS IN THAT COUNTRY. DAVIS HAD
NO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.
