

Reward due for JFK facts

Hustler magazine publisher Larry Flynt, who recently began redirecting his energies from smut to spirituality, will announce a \$1 million reward for access to information leading to "the truth" about the assassination of John F. Kennedy.

Flynt has bought full-page advertisements Sunday in 10 major newspapers, including The Dallas Morning News, to appeal to anyone with knowledge of those who participated in a Kennedy "conspiracy."

"I am personally guaranteeing a \$1 million reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of anyone involved in the planning or execution of President Kennedy's murder, or for information which makes it possible for the truth to come out," Flynt says.

"No more coverups. No more secret testimony behind closed doors. This may be our last chance to uncover the truth behind President Kennedy's assassination in Dallas."

This is the latest in a series of unusual activities by Flynt since November, when he was led to a highly publicized religious conversion by Ruth Carter Stapleton, President Carter's evangelist sister.

After promising "drastic" changes in the format of his sexually explicit publications Hustler and Chic, Flynt also announced plans for an illustrated Bible and a television documentary on the roots of violence.

Last month, Flynt bought \$200,000 worth of full-page ads in newspapers to announce he was retreating with his wife and children and comedian-activist Dick Gregory to an undisclosed spot for a vigil to pray for world peace, an

end to hunger and for cancer-stricken Sen. Hubert Humphrey.

Cynthia Johnson, Flynt's associate in his publishing headquarters in Columbus, Ohio, said that among the responses Flynt received from that ad was a touching letter from a couple in Tyler.

It said, "We read the ad in The Dallas Morning News, and we think Sen. Humphrey is the greatest. We thank God for him and we join you in prayer for him."

"Please accept this small contribution because we feel a responsibility to this good man also."

"You too have proven to stand for that which is right."
