There will never be another official government investigation of JFK's assassination. Now an insider tells why. Fonzi reveals how and why the committee refused to hear public testimony from key witnesses, avoided taking action against high-ranking intelligence agents who committed perjury, and deliberately tilted its investigative plan and then distorted its interpretation of evidence in order to give its final report media "sex appeal" and the false appearance of substance.

There are no wild conspiracy theories here, no reckless assertions of government cover-up and official duplicity. Fonzi offers suspenseful accounts of discovering new evidence of conspiracy and tracking elusive witnesses, only to find them suddenly dead under mysterious circumstances. He tells of personal encounters with a weird cast of characters who emerge from the shadows with vital information and credible credentials, yet set tracks that go in circles. He also reveals the significant new evidence that he uncovered—the first verified link between the CIA and Lee Harvey Oswald—and then discloses how the Assassination Committee bosses deliberately slammed the door on efforts to pursue it.

This dramatically developed story details far more pivotal and potentially explosive areas of the Kennedy assassination than any book yet published and reveals aspects of the Select Committee's investigation never made public. *The Last Investigation* is of interest to anyone who wants to understand what went wrong with the government probe.
