WHILF HEOVER, IN AGENCY MEMOS, DID NOT FIDE HIS SUCCESSION MUSTICE FARM WARPEN COMMISSION, F1DE HIS SUCCESSION

WHILF NEGVER, IN AGENCY MEMCS, DID NOT FIDE HIS SUSPICION CHIFF JUSTICE FAEL WAPPEND WAS LEAKING DETAILS OF FBI REPORTS TO THE MEDIA, THE DIRFCTOR MIMSELF KEPT TABS ON WARPEN'S PANEL THROUGH FORD. FCED, WHO DESCRIBED HIMSELF AS THE CLLY MINOR ITY MEMORE OF THE COMMISSION, WAS IN TOUCH WITH TOP HOOVED ALDE CAFTHA D. DELCACH CHLY DAYS AFTER THE PANEL STARTED ITS INVESTIGATION OF JOHN KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION, ACCEPTING TO RAW FBI FILES. DELCACH FEPCETED TO HOOVER ON DEC. 12, 1963 FORD HAD CONFIDED HIS MISGIVINGS ABOUT THE WAY WARPEN WAS RUNNING THE COMMISSION. FORD WAS PARTICULA ELY CONCEPTED WARPEN WAS "ATTEMPTING TO ESTABLISH A 'CUE MAN' COMMISSION' BY APPOINTING A CHIFF COUNSEL, WAFLEN' CLNEY, THAT WAS HIS GUN PECTEGE, DELCACH REPORTED. HOOVER BLOCKED CLNEY'S APPOINTMENT AND FORMER SOLICITOR GENERAL J. LEE FANKIN WAS SELFCTED AS CHIFF COUNSEL. DELCACH SAID "FORD.INDICATED HE WOULD KEEP ME THOROUGHLY ADVISED AS TO THE ACTIVITIES OF THE OCHNISSION ... ON A CONFIDENTIAL BASIS."

AS TO THE ACTIVITIES OF THE COMMISSION ... UN A CONFIDENTIAL BASIS." HE ADDED "WE HAVE HAD EXCELLENT ENLATIONS WITH CONGRESSMAN FORD FOR MANY YEARS" AND NOTED "HE HAS BEEN GIVEN AN AUTOGRAPHED COPY OF THE DIFECTCE'S BOGK, 'A STUDY OF COMMUNISM,' AND HAS BEEN IN TOUCH WITH MY OFFICE ON MUMEROUS OCCASIONS IN THE PAST."

"CONTACT WILL BE MAINTAINED WITH CONGRESSMAN FORD," DELCACH SAID.

"CG MTACT WILL BE MAINTAINED WITH CG NGRESSMAN FCED," DELCACH SAID. HCCVFE MCTED ON THE MENC "WILL HANDLED." A FEW DAYS LATFR, DELCACH MET AGAIN WITH FCED WHO TOLD HIM THE CCMMISSION HAD DISCUSSED LEAKS OF THE PEELIMINARY FBI REPORT BUT, "THEEF WERE NO ALLEGATIONS MADE BY ANY ONE, INCLUDING THE CHIEF JUST ICE, THAT THE FBI HAD LEAKED PORTIONS OF THIS REPORT." DELCACH INDICATED TO FORD THE FBI LEADERSHIP SUSPECTED WARFEN HIMSELF WAS THE LEAKEF. HCCVER APPROVED LENDING FOED ONE OF ITS AGENTS' BRIEFCASES WITH A LGCK SC THE THEN-CONGRESSMAN COULD TAKE THE CONFIDENTIAL FBI REPORT HOME TO MICHIGAN FOR CHEISTMAS. FORD HIMSELF, RESPONDING TO ALLEGATIONS THAT HE HAD LEAKED INFORMATION FECH LEE HARVEY CSWALD'S DIAKY TO A DALLAS IFWSPAPER, ASKED THE FBI TO INTERVIEW HIM SC HE COULD DENY THE ALLEGATIONS. HE WAS THE OMLY COMMISSION MEMBER INTERVIEWED IN AN EXHAUSTIVE SFARCH FCR THE SOURCE OF THE LEAK. THE FBI CCICLUDED FOED HAD NOTHING TO DO WITH THE LEAK AND THAT ITS SCURCE WAS THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE IN DALLAS.
