Gerald Ford, The Television Writer? Yes — but not until after the election of 1976. The book written by then Congressman Ford in 1965 about the assassination of President John F. Kennedy titled "Portrait Of An Assassin" is the subject of negotiations by CBS-TV. Mr. Ford was a member of the Warren Commission which investigated the assassination and his exhaustive 500-page study ("written with" John R. Sfiles) would become a three or four-hour documentary produced by MGM. There is one major condition: it must not be shown before the election of 1976 since Mr. Ford is an announced candidate.
