

Ford Won't Open Probe Of JFK

WASHINGTON — President Ford opposed Tuesday the reopening of the investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy on the grounds that no evidence has been produced to discredit the original Warren Commission findings.

Press Secretary Ron Nessen made it clear that Mr. Ford is not prepared to support a suggestion by Sen. Richard S. Schweiker (R-Pa.), a member of the Senate Intelligence Committee, that the investigation be reopened.
