The most important thing here is to qualify the credibility of the witness. This has not been done in the past, and particularly where it bears on the assassin being in the Book Depository Building. A very important link in the case -- and the most frequently raised question is, did the shooting come from this building.

- 3) Was it feasible from a time standpoint for Oswald to make it from the Sixth floor to the coke machine? What route would he have taken? What were Truly's movements from the time of assassination until Oswald was seen at the Coke machine?
- 4) Was there any reason that Oswald could not have exited after that easily as he must have done?
