- 5) transcript -- if it exists -- of interrogations of of Usw 1d from the time of his appr chension until denise.
- 6) results of post mostem performed on Usw 1d is may relate to factorseffecting his stability, sinity etc.
- 7) details run down by FBI on alleged threatt by Cs ld to shoot wiron (a fallow up interview with Larina re grain this was provised by . I, not s ret recrived.)
