Dear Mr. Lesar:

This is in further reference to your Freedom of Information Act request on Percy Foreman.

I would like to inform you that 115 pages of public source information have been located, assembled and processed under the provisions of the FOIA and released.

Please advise us should you wish to obtain the above-mentioned information and it will be sent to you.

Following a preliminary review of additional documents pertaining to your request, it is estimated that duplication costs of approximately \$195 may result, representing a charge of 10¢ per page. Department of Justice regulations (Title 28, Code of Federal Regulations, Sections 16.10 and 16.47) require notification to a requester when anticipated charges exceed \$25. This letter constitutes such notification.

Accordingly, before taking action, we will await receipt of written notification indicating your willingness to pay fees of approximately \$195 in connection with the processing of your request. If you want to reduce the scope of your request to meet your needs at a lower cost, please advise this office at your earliest convenience.


We must caution, however, that your indication of approval and consent to incur such fees will not necessarily result in the entire contents of our records being disclosed to you, since we are guided by the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act (Title 5, United States Code, Section 552) and the Privacy Act of 1974 (Title 5, United States Code, Section 552a) in disclosing material from our records. No duplication fees will be assessed for documents not released.
