On July 29, 1976, Assistant U. S. Attorney James A. Rolfe, Northern District of Texas, Dallas, made available a copy of a court order signed by Halbert O. Woodward, U. S. District Judge, Northern District of Texas, Lubbock, Texas, on June 24, 1976, in the case of the United States of America vs. Percy Foreman, Criminal No. 3-75-281, which order states:

"The motion of the defendant Percy Foreman for transfer of venue of the above case from the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas to the United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas, Houston Division, is granted and said case is here so transferred. However, the undersigned judge will try the case in the Houston Division of the Southern District of Texas.
