NY Times Mar 12 Forrestal broke 3 yr. silence imposed on military for use of "biological warfare"

by Army Chief of Staff D D Eisenhower

- Report submitted then withdrawn by War Dept.

- prepared by George W. Merck Am. Chem. manufacturer

- told of successful efforts by allies to be prepared for Axis possible use of germ. warfare - Headed War Research Service

- Gen Waitt - Chief Army Chem. Corps also "no stockpiles for germ warfare at that time"

later headed US Bio Warfare Committee

JVF • flown from Hobe Sound Fla. to Bethl. Hosp. on Sat Apr. 2nd - entered as "ambulatory patient" - nervous and physical exhaustion

Sun Apr 17 Capt BW Hogan says JV F is recovering from occupational fatigue

- only a matter of time - predicts JV F will have "no turns for the worse"

regaining "lost 25 lbs."

- "radios & telephones" barred from room"

Apr 28

Sec of Def L Johnson visits JVF
"looks fine" - out by mid May "predicts
Pres Truman via L.S. offers plane for
"round the world trip" after JVF gets out!

May 18 -

- denounced for "alleged" preference to Arab oil over Jews!

- 3 weeks previous - Med intern was withdrawn from JVF's room!
only kept at desk outside door

- worked for ^(strong) big Navy
- against Army - Navy merger

- Diary or journal filled cabinet - requested transference to White House from Fla. stint - better protection

- excellent reference journal!
