At least twice he said the curtain rods had been bought for Lee by Marima. Lee told him this on way to ¹rving and next a.m. on way back to Dalles

"He seid he was going to see Marina to get some curtain rods she had bought for him."

There are other points in Frazier's testimony that address the intentions of the Commission and its staff, the honesty of the deposition, the dishonesty of the Report and a number of other elements all consistent with the misreppresentation of Oswald. For exemple, on their arrival at the TSED "about eight or 10 minutes before eight" (T-P):

> He parked the car and sat there charging thebattery "Lee stood there waiting", remembered Frazier,"But then he walked off and I never caught up with him.... "Did you see him enter the building?", queried Alcock. "Yes, I did", said Frazier."I saw him enter the book depository several times."

All ofthis is inconsistent with the testimony that was elicited by the WC, and it seems only because the Commission found this testimony uncongenial.
