Dear Jack,

Thanks for your letter of the 6th. I should also have asked if the FBI or S was ever there to check on the Ryder guest book or anything else relevant.

I never hear from Garrison. Quite the opposite is true, we are daily learning more about the assassination. Unfortunately, Garrison added nothing but confusion. The possibilities for his having added real knowledge were great.

From other sources, I understand his book is due 10/1. I have heard nothing about it or its contents, and he did not disclose to me even that he was writing it (although I had assumed he would write one).

On the OSWALD'S in New Orleans, I am having to turn down requests for them and would welcome the copies you have. If you paid for them, I'd appreciate it if you send them to me, deducting what you owe me and billing me for the rest. If you did not pay for them, I have yet to get a cent from Canyon. This may seem incredible, but it is the painful fact. So, it is not I who could have come out ahead on the deal and not you who will lose. I would, however, like to be able to fill orders. The book is no longer available. The copies that were to have been sent me were never sent.


