MISCELLANEOUS; INFORMATION CONCERNING

Mr. FRAZIER, of the Lab, advised he would be leaving from the Baltimore airport via Delta Flight 921, at 3:20 p.m., arriving New Orleans 4:47 p.m., today.

He requested that he be notified, even at the Baltimore airport if he were not needed tomorrow and he will not board the plane until 3:10 p.m.

SA DREILING WILL: 1) contact Assistant U. S. Attorney CONNICK, so you can be immediately advised in the event Mr. FRAZIER is not going to be needed tomorrow.

2) Make appropriate room reservations at a hotel for Mr. FRAZIER.

3) See that Mr. FRAZIER is met at the airport.

4) Determine if Mr. CONNICK desires a conference with him tonight or early in the morning.
