OVER 4,000 YEARS OF HISTORY was dramatically recorded in "The Nile," a photographic exhibition at Hood College.

SEVERAL sidewalk spectators were photographed along West Church Street in Frederick craning their necks to watch a daring worker sitting atop the ball of the Trinity Chapel steeple. The worker was sanding the ball in preparation for gold leaf painting.

A PROGRESS report was scheduled in the Circuit Court room of the courthouse by Frederick County's three delegates to the Maryland Constitutional Convention. Samuel W. Barrick, Benjamin B. Rosenstock and Edward D. Storm were to report on their respective committees, local government, judicial and executive.

SIX WILD geese were donated to the Baltimore Zoo by Harold Weisburg who had shipped flocks of geese and ducks as far away as Ghana, Africa. The geese were the last of his flocks as he prepared to move from his Hyattstown farm. They were scheduled for passage on a Civil Air Patrol flight from Frederick to Baltimore.
