I have received your letter of April 10, 1967 and wish to thank you for writing to me and taking an interest in my endeavor to learn more about assassination of President Kennedy.

In ref. to the Testimony of Mrs. Lee Harvey Oswald. Vol. 1, pp 13.

Q. Do you recall the first time that you observed the rifle?

A. That was on Neely Street. I think that was in February.

The rifle was shipped from Chicago on March 20, 1963.

Again Mrs. Oswald saw the rifle in February.

Did Oswald have more than one rifle?

Also in ref. to Commission exhibit 183.

In a letter from Oswald to his mother.

Although Oswald has dated the letter "Oct 23, 1959."

This was obviously an error as, in the letter, Oswald mentions receiving a gift from his wife, Maria, on his birthday, "a gold and silver cup with the inscription "to my dear husband on his birthday 18/X/61," and the dating error is further confirmed by the postmarks. The formal report of the Warren Commission, although they had possession of this letter did not choose to point up the facts in this error.

Maybe some day we can arrange to meet and discuss so many matters of mutual interest.
