

Fulbright and Nobel

STOCKHOLM — Sen. William J. Fulbright (D-Ark.) will be the focus of attention during the week of festivities surrounding the awarding of the Nobel prizes in early December. Fulbright, who is extremely popular in Sweden because of his opposition to U.S. Vietnam policy, will make at least two speeches and be a guest at the Nobel award banquet during his scheduled visit to Sweden Dec. 4 to Dec. 11. The Nobel prizes in medicine, chemistry, physics and literature will be announced in October and early November. The Peace Prize is awarded by a committee of the Norwegian Parliament in Oslo.
