I will not need help in printing my King assassination book if I self-publish again. An old friend will help with the printing.

However, I will probably want some help, something a bit more than a gofer, someone to make the searches now largely beyond me, particularly to locate records of which I did not make copies as I went over the originals and to provide the identification of those to which I'll refer but will not want to reproduce in full in the appendix.

There is a fine young woman who helped me for a while. She has returned to her family home in Vermont, near the Canadian border, to help with sick folks and try to decide what she wants to do with herself now that she has her master's degree. I don't know whether she'd consider returning for a while but I've written to ask her.

If I can get to that point at a time that coincides with college vacations, perhaps the experience would be useful to a journalism or polisci major.

I'm getting some records that had been withheld, from the files of the Attorney General and the Deputy. One of these has a lawyer in the AG's office suspecting that the late Stanley Levison was an FBI informer. Levison was close to King, very close. I have no reason to credit the suspicion and I've not seen any FBI records that provide any basis for it, but there is no equivocation in this memo to files.

I understand that other similar records are being processed but that none is unequivocal on this.
