Dear Harold:


I talked briefly with Adam Hochschild, an editor of Mother Jones, a monthly magazine, (607 Market Street, San Francisco, CA 94105, 415/495-6326) about your work.

I suggested that a worthwhile article would bring readers up to date on what is clearly established in terms of the assassination plots against John Kennedy and Dr. King; what is strongly indicated, and what can be discounted on the basis of equally strong evidence. In the light of the House action on an investigation of the murders, the piece would be timely. Hochschild was positive about the idea and would like to have an outline from you. As I mentioned to him and to you, I am not trying to play agent, but I do think a solid piece needs to sort out a huge pile of theories, hypotheses, speculations and -- realities.

Mother Jones pays about 10 - 15 cents a word and they might have some ideas about a book publisher.
