Incidentally, I recall very clearly an incident on TV the day of the assassination, or the following day -- which I have heard no more about. I wonder if you are aware of any details or follow-up. A man was interviewed by Dallas reporters, who identified himself as a performer who did memory acts. He asserted that he had been at Ruby's club a short time previous (whether as a performer or a patron I cannot recall clearly), and remembered Oswald being there.

I am grateful to you for your hard work in exposing the deficiencies in the official versions of what happened, although your style of writing would be much more persuasive if it were less colored by emotional outbursts, invective, and ridicule. After all, the strongest case is made by the facts themselves.
