I take it there have been no further untoward incidents.

The current exposes of CIA domestic activities are of interest to me. If you get Newsday, which does not get this far away from Long Island, and if clipping any stories it may carry is no problem for you, I would appreciate them. (Three of the last time times I was at the local news agency the Times did not get here!)

While the reporting may appear to be sensational, it is much less than adequate and does not include what will be found in the morgues (i.e., libraries) of most major newspapers.

However, there is a well-orchestrated loading, if no real investigations. Any one seemingly insignificant fact in any leak can have importance that may not be immediately apparent to those who have not made a specialized study.

Hence the interest in what Newsday may publish.

But please do not get it for this and if the clipping is a problem (you are both a student and a housewife as I recall) please do not undertake what can be troublesome to you.

If you can, thanks.
