Dear Mr. Grabowski,

I appreciate your letter. I hope you won't mind my writing you on a reusable discarded page of the manuscript of a new book for which no publication has yet been arranged.

I am sorry I can't take the time to respond in detail. I'm 80 and not well and want yet to do what work I can.

I enclose a list of all our books.

We agree on the evils of the revisionists who do not really address what kind of President Kennedy was and more, was becoming. Nothing ~~is~~ else counts!

We will never know the truth not because that will not be allowed but because the government never investigated the crime and never intended to. So there are no smoking guns in the records (of which I got about 250,000 by 13 FOIA lawsuits) yet to be disclosed and there is no likelihood of any official effort to establish the truth. All the many flawed books theorizing solutions confuse all even more and serve to protect those in the government who failed us, then and since then. (You will find no theories in my books.)

I regret to say that Mark Lane bought no records to light. Most of that has been done by my friend Mark Allen after my illness prevented my continuing with that litigation and by me. Jim Lesar was my lawyer and is Allen's. Without him we could not have gotten all those pages out. And I add ignored by all those who commercialized and exploited with the flawed books of theory not one of which is proven or even provable.
