I do not know your sources but they are wrong.

Dell rejected Whitewash in 1965, three times before publishing it in as I now recall December, 1966.

No edition could have been made available to the public before 1965 because it was not completed until February, 1965. I then did make some copies of the limited edition available to a few people but not to Dell other than as I submitted it for consideration for publication.

I sent a copy of the general edition of May 1966 to Marguerite Oswald. She had not ordered it.

It now is not physically possible for me to retrieve and copy for you the NYTimes story you request. It can be retrieved for a number of retrieval services, including that of the Times.
