Dear Mr. Granata,

Three of my four published books (the fifth is ready but I cannot now risk the added debt) are available in paperback. The first two were issued by Dell and should be available from the Los Angeles wholesaler who handles Dell books. Oswald in New Orleans is handled by Southern California Magazine Co (L & S Dist. in S.F.) If you buy in class-size quantity you should be able to get the book - store discount.

We have only the original editions of our books. While reproduced by offset from the typescript, they are on the best paper, with a stitched binding, and will last. Our discounts are 40% on orders of five or more, total, meaning any combination. We can provide indexes of WHITEWASH II and OSWALD IN NEW ORLEANS for the standard local reproxing charge of 20 cents per page.

Increasingly, high schools are getting interested in this subject. I think it is a good and a healthy sign.

Please excuse the haste. The trip stacked my work that much higher.
