Dear Richard,

Yesterday and the day before I got long phone calls from strangers who had just read Case Open and just had to thank me and praise me for what they believed was the "courage" writing the book required. I think the reaction is exaggerated but it is pleasant and it, while not daily, is surprisingly often and tells me that some bookstores still have the books and sell them. It also suggests what could have been.

And it reminds me that it has been a long time since I've seen any accounting. I am not suggesting that money is due me and have no reason to believe any is. It is just that we have no records of what the sales were and our books should, I think, have this information.

I have reason to believe that in about three or four months perhaps a bit longer, there will be a situation that should make for a market for NEVER AGAIN! in particular.

I hope that whatever the problem was that changed you so has run its course and is of the past.
