If as I suspect he has had access to only the published official records he is in the role of defense counsel, something Oswald was never had.

That in itself should have some appeal.

You say it is done well. If so I think it is a natural, none so when there is all this interest in the assassination and when most of the books are obvious trash and yet sell well.

This one could even be a good one, in my terms, if he did what he told me he did as well as a former FBI agent should have been able to.
