Yours listsof tapes is promising-looking, and your files of organized clip ings may be very valuable. I hope you proserve them intact. Perhaps some day they can become part of an archive.

I will remember your invetion, for which I am grateful, and possibly some time I can accept it. What I'd like to do, some time when have to stay over night in New York, is visit you that night and see what you do have.

Mark Lane has left the New York area. Where he will make his pandament residence, I do not know. I heard he was going to teach and Stanford, then * heard he was going to Haw Orleans for the duration of the trial.

You have a number of tapes that I do not. I'm glad to know what you do have.

On your flyer, may I suggest that is it not precise to say that everything in the Archives is menied everyone? By now I am confident more than half of the meterial is accessible to qualified researchers. There is still too much suppressionary is too much. From the very beginning, however, some of it was available. As the staff of the Archives can arrange it, additional sections are made available. For example, ten more boxes of certains kinds of papers were opened today. I will begin looking that them tomorrow. On the other hand, the Consission banned some materials, as you know from my writings, and federal agencies, notably the FEI and CI1, other large segments.
